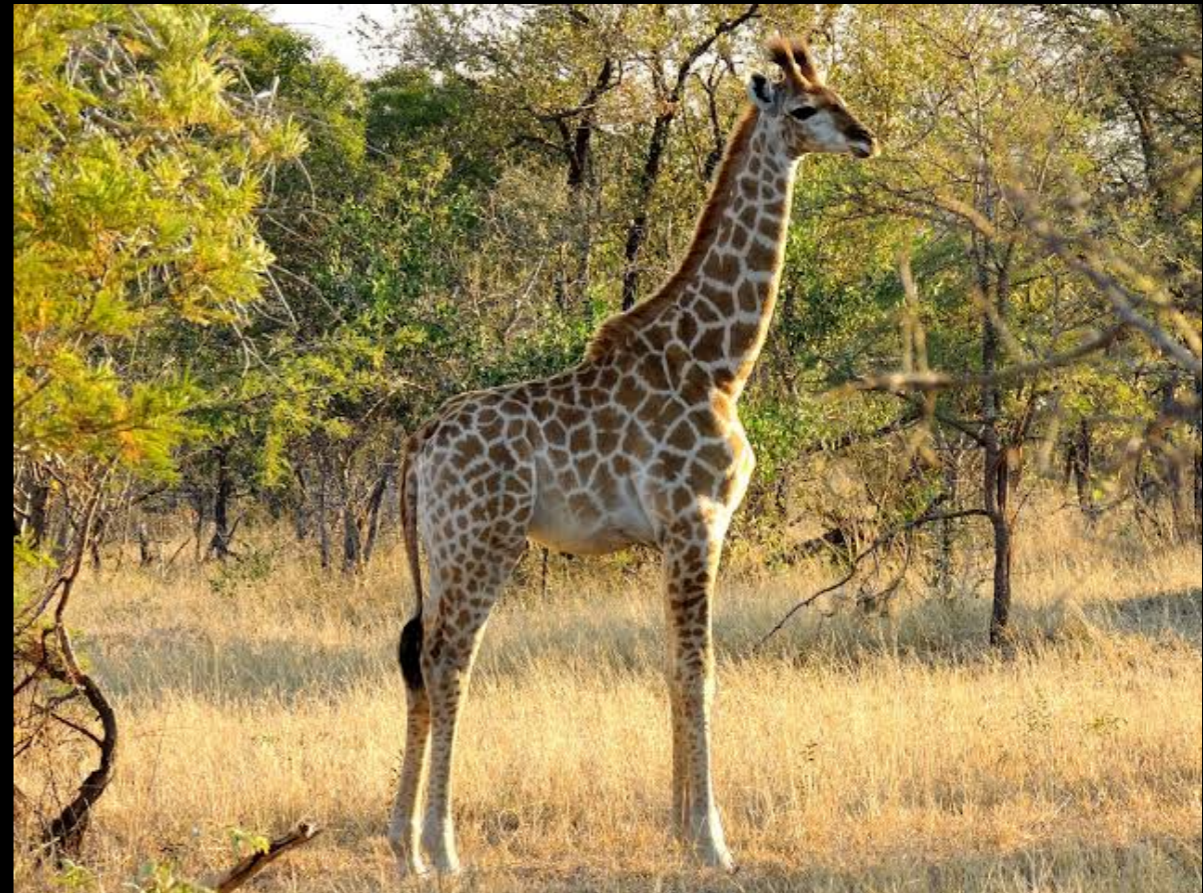
Why are dog's noses wet?
